Rafting Class II and III

This beautiful **HAGERMAN HIGH DESERT SECTION** of the Snake River offers plenty of whitewater excitement. Our licensed guides are very knowledgeable on the history of the river and the surrounding area.

Idaho is well known for its amazing geology and this river section offers spectacular examples of how the Snake River cuts through Southern Idaho. Wildlife and waterfowl are abundant along the river corridor. Natural springs from the Snake River Aquifer flow into the river. This trip is great for ages 6 and up.

Meeting Place: Lower Salmon Falls Dam

Trip Times: 10:30 am with riverside lunch – 3:30 pm with no food service

Approximate trip length: 3.5 hours. All trips require a reservation.



Kayak, SUP, or Canoe

Paddle your own watercraft with a guide down the Snake River. The **THOUSAND SPRINGS SECTION** offers a flat water paddle with an easy down river current. Experience beautiful waterfalls, scenery, waterfowl, and birds of prey. On this trip you will pass by Box Canyon, paddle into Blue Heart Springs, and adventure around Ritter Island. This is a wonderful way to experience the Snake River up close and personal. Recommended for ages 6 and up. **ASK ABOUT OUR BILLINGSLEY CREEK PADDLE.** Meeting Place: Billingsley Creek Lodging








Blue Heron, ducks, birds of prey, beavers, and muskrats make up some of the wildlife that live on the property. Billingsley Creek is an oasis in Southern Idaho's high desert with plenty of green grass and shade trees to relax under. For our registered guests we have a barbecue area with picnic tables and fire pit available Memorial Weekend through Labor Day.

Billingsley Creek Lodging is a very unique property. We have a maximum occupancy number of 26 people per day, this allows our guests to enjoy the property and creek without feeling crowded.

Safety

Safety first is our rule. We realize everyone has a different idea of adventure so we have designed our trips from “Mild to Wild”. Our guides are all trained in whitewater boating skills, emergency care, and river rescue techniques. All are licensed and bonded by the State of Idaho and all carry first aid credentials. Your safety is our first priority.

River Ratings

Class I: Moving water with few riffles and small waves. Few or no obstructions.

Class II: Easy rapids with waves up to 3 feet and wide, clear channels that are obvious without scouting. Some maneuvering is required.

Class III: Rapids with high, irregular waves often capable of swamping an open canoe. Narrow passages that often require complex maneuvering. May require shore scouting.

Class IV: Long, difficult rapids with constricted passages that often require precise maneuvering in turbulent waters. Scouting from shore is often necessary. Conditions make rescue difficult.

Class V: Extremely difficult, long, and very violent rapids with highly congested routes that almost always must be scouted from shore. Rescue conditions are difficult and there is significant hazard to life in the event of a mishap.

Class VI: Same difficulties of Class V except to the extreme of navigational abilities. Nearly impossible and very dangerous. For teams of experts only after close study.
